- *\$1700 Off Grid
 - * \$1600 Non-Drug offenses of severity level 1 - 5 and drug offenses with 6 or more hours in court
 - * \$1200 Non-drug offenses of severity level 6 - 10 and drug offenses with 6 or less hours in court
- Non-Grid is level 10
Off-Grid is level 00
